DETAILS OF WORK

On September 24, 1952, 7" casing was landed at 4350 feet and cemented with 300 sacks of cement. Plug down at 3130 ft., September 24, 1952. At 3:30 P.M., September 26, 1952, casing and water shut-off were tested at 1200 pounds pump pressure for 30 minutes. No drop in pressure. Forty-seven feet of solid cement were drilled in bottom of pipe and water shut-off was again tested at 1200 pounds for 30 minutes. No drop in pressure. Drilling operations were resumed.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.

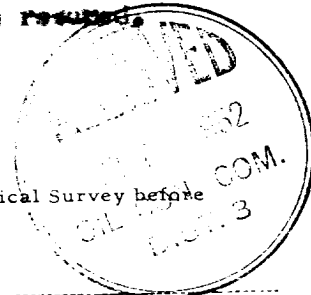
