Gentlemen:

On the March, 1960, San Juan Gas Proration schedule Aztec Oil & Gas Company's Current #1 (E-11-T30N-R11W) in the Aztec-Pictured Cliffs Pool connected to El Paso Natural Gas Company had an allowable of 3409 MCF. On the April, 1960, similar schedule the allowable for this well for March, 1960, was shown as 6432 MCF, which apparently was in error for a 160-acre well with a deliverability of 145 MCF/D. The May, 1960, similar schedule, the March, 1960, production showed 1638 MCF and an underproduction of 482 MCF.

It is believed that if the correct March, 1960, allowable was used that that over/under status at the end of March, 1960, would be 2541 MCF overproduced rather than being underproduced.

Please check your records on the allowables and production on the above well and possibly you will need to issue a correction as to the over/under status of the well as we have pointed out.
