Gentlemen:

Northwest Supplement No. 4590, dated February 19, 1959, shows a February 1959 net allowable of 28,543 MCF for EPNG's Lindsey No. 2 B-11, 30-N, 9-W, and a March 1959 current allowable of 34,854 MCF. This information is also in accordance with our records.

However, Supplement No. SF-708, dated March 12, 1959, orders this same well shut-in effective March 1, 1959, for being six times over-produced. According to our records, this well is 62,957 MCF under-produced as of April 30, 1959.

If your records reflect this same situation, will you please issue the necessary Release of Shut-in as soon as possible.

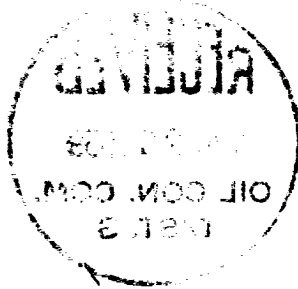
