*7. Plug Cement AFTER PLUG #2 (STEPS) & PROCEED ACCORDINGLY WITH A MINIMUM OF 3 HRS.
TAG CEMENT AFTER PLUG #3 (STEPS) IF CEMENT DOES NOT CIRCULATE TO SURFACE OR BRAIDENHEAD TO 135'
TO SURFACE OR BRAIDENHEAD TO 135'*

7. Close braidenhead valve & open pipe rams & circ 35 sx cmt in csg. (To fill inside csg to 585' plus 50% excess). C.O. short way & TOH to 135'.
8. If circulation out of braidenhead hasn't already been achieved, perf 2 sq holes thru tbg @ 135'. With pipe rams closed & braidenhead valve open circ cmt out braidenhead. (20 sx)
9. Close braidenhead valve & open pipe rams a circ cmt out 5-1/2" csg (16 sx). TOH.
10. Cut off wellhead below surface casing flange and install dry hole marker to State specs.
11. Restore location to state specs.
