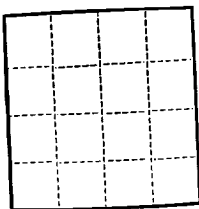

DETAILS OF WORK

It is intended to drill a well with rotary tools thru the Mesa Verde formation. Mud circulation will be used thru the Pictured Cliffs and set intermediate casing. Gas circulation will be used thru the Mesa Verde and a production liner will be set. Possible productive intervals will be perforated & fractured. Estimated T.B. 4010'. It is intended to dual complete the Pictured Cliffs and Mesa Verde formations.

Casing Program:

- 10 3/4" at 170' with 125 sacks cement circulated to surface.
- 7 5/8" at 4500' with 250 sacks cement.
- 5 1/2" at 4010' with 150 sacks cement.

The 2 of Section 6 is dedicated to this well.

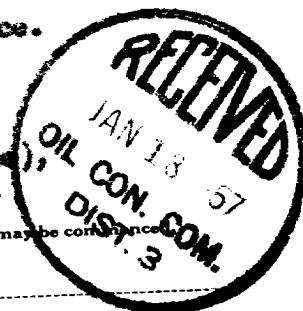

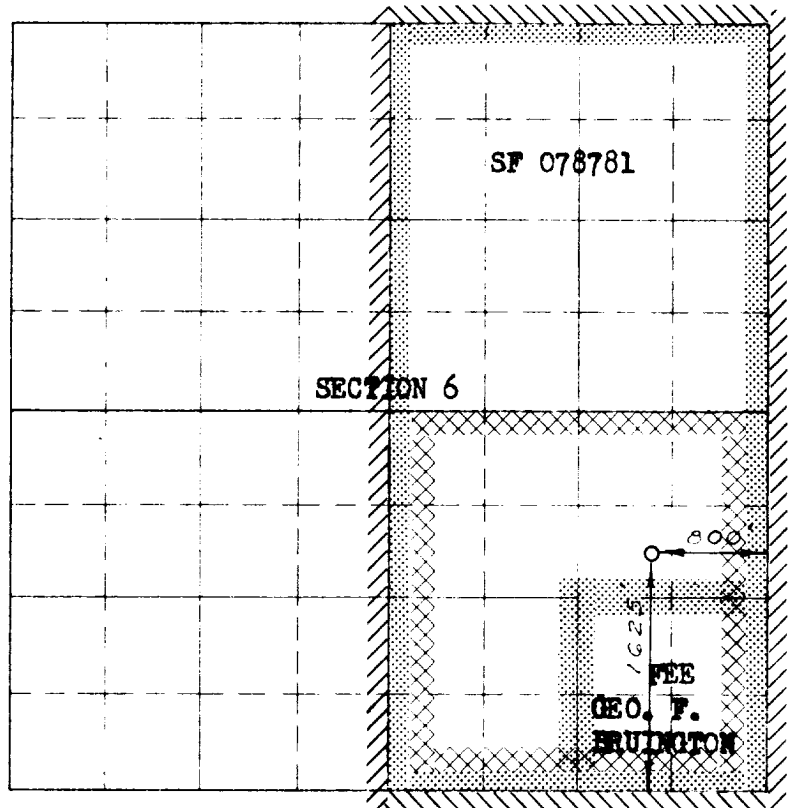
