Tubing is currently stuck in this hole at a depth of 3500 ft. Attempts to pull this tubing have failed so far. We are going to attempt to pull this tubing again around the 22nd of March, using a bigger rig and mud pump for circulation. Current production on this well averages about 10 bbl of oil a week and no water. If tubing can be pulled, well will be put back into operation as soon as shale can be cleaned out of bottom of hole.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.
