Enclosed are seven copies of the Notice of Intention to Change Plans on our Yager Pool Unit No. 2 in NW/4 Sec. 6, T-30N, R-11W, N. M. P. M., San Juan County, New Mexico.

This well has been drilled through the Pictured Cliffs formation and found to be non-productive at that depth.

It is our desire to salvage the hole and casing in place by drilling the well through the Mesaverde formation, even though the location is in the NW/4 and does not conform with the Blanco spacing of a NE/4 or SW/4 location.

El Paso Natural Gas Company has operating rights on all of Sec. 6, T-30N, R-11W, except the SE/4 of SE/4. In surrounding sections, El Paso has operating rights as follows: Sec. 5, T-30N, R-11W - 160 acres in W/2; Sec. 7, T-30N, R-11W - 40 acres in N/2; Sec. 1, T-30N, R-12W - 40 acres in E/2; Sec. 31, T-31N, R-11W - 320 acres in S/2; Sec. 36, T-31N, R-12W - 120 acres in S/2.
