DETAILS OF WORK

Set approximately 200' of 10-3/4" 32.75# M-40 Surface casing & circulate cement.

Set approximately 3500' of 7-5/8" 26.40# J-55 Intermediate casing & circulate cement with a two stage tool.

Set approximately 8000' of 5-1/2" 15.50# & 17# J-55 Production casing and cement the Dakota & Mesaverde Formations.

Perforate the Dakota Formation and sand-water free with approximately 50,000 gal. water & 50,000 lbs sand.

Perforate the Mesaverde Formation and sand-water free with approximately 100,000 gal water & 100,000 lbs sand.

Set a Baker Model "D" Production Packer at approximately 7800' & run 2-3/8" tubing with an "Otis" Cross-over tool at approximately 5800'. We plan to produce the Dakota through tubing & the Mesaverde through annulus.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.

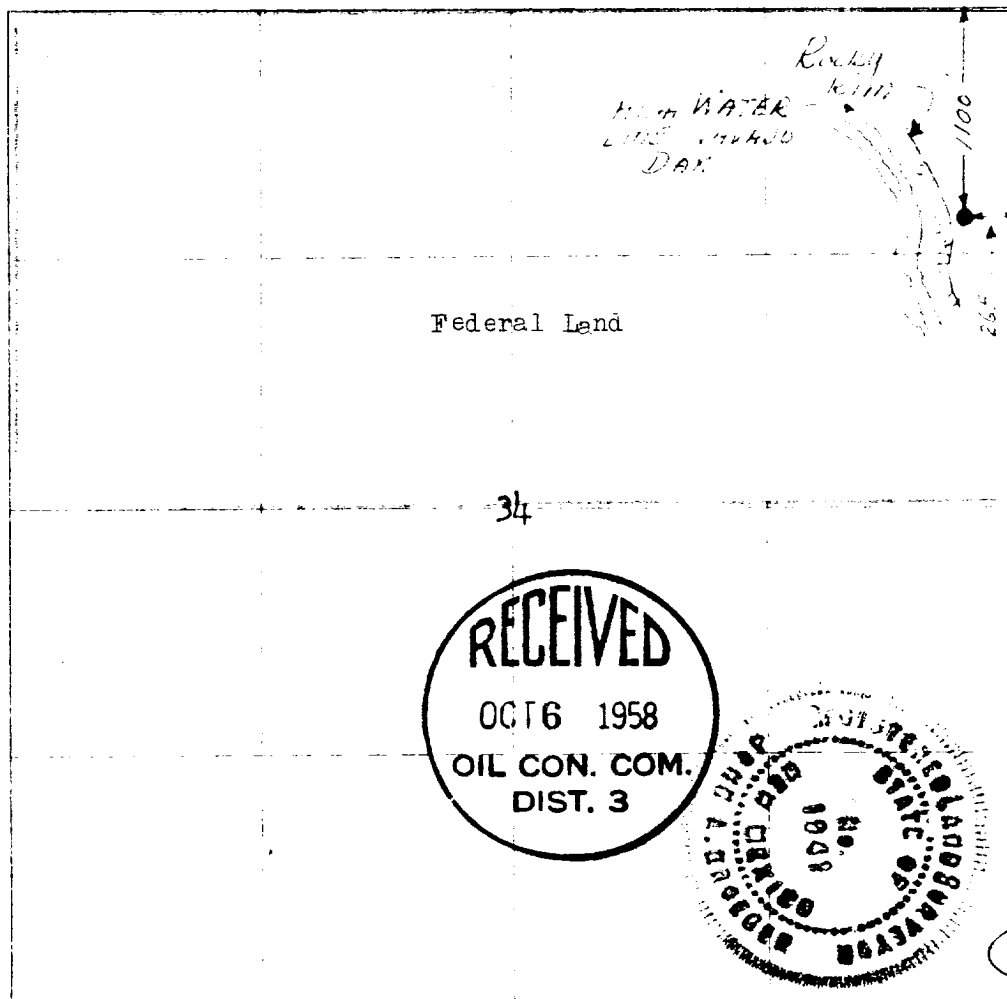
