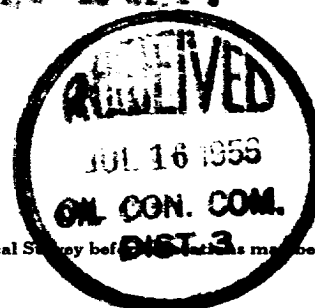

DETAILS OF WORK

Drilled to Total Depth of 5810', ran 116 jts 5-1/2" casing, while running the 116th jt of 5-1/2", pin on 116th jt, pulled out collar of 115th jt. Fished for 5-1/2" casing at 1538', recovered 63 jts. of pipe, top of fish was then at 4038', was not able to recover the rest of the pipe. Ran 150 cc cement plug w/15% sand. W.O.C., dropped off cement plug from 3477'-3900', set whipstock at 3900', drilled hole to 5810' (Total Depth), max deviation was 4-1/2" at 4111'.
