DETAILS OF WORK

(State names of and expected depths to objective sands; show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudding jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work)

The objective sands are the Cliff House and Point Lookout, expected at approximately 5150' and 5600' respectively. The proposed casing program is as follows:

200' of 9-5/8" O.D. casing cemented to surface
5150' of 7" O.D. cemented with 200 sacks

Well will be drilled with rotary tools to top of Cliff House where casing will be set. Pay zones will be drilled using natural gas drilling method to a total depth of approximately 5800' and will then be shot from about 5200' to total depth with 2000 quarts of nitro glycerin.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.

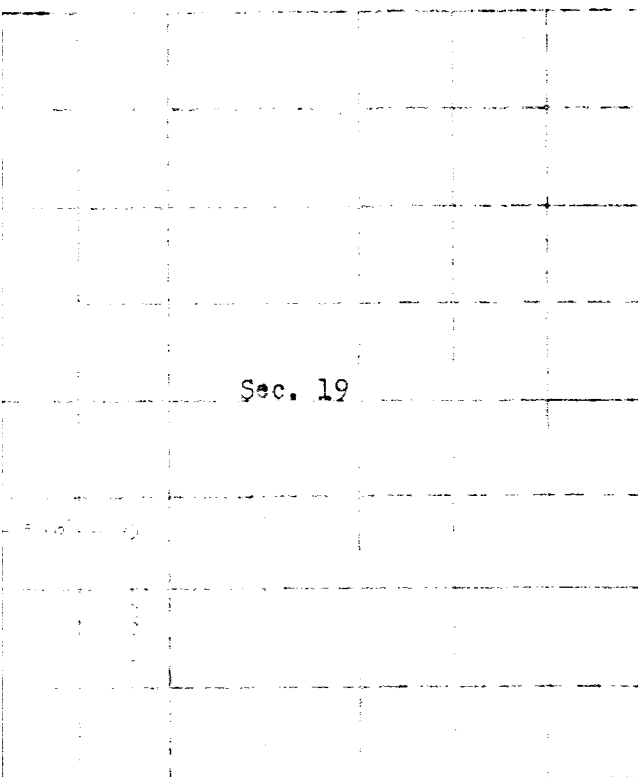
