- 1) The 7" retainer will be set @ +/- 5250', instead of 5100'.
- 2) A Baker DW-1 packer will be set at +/- 4000', instead of a CIBP set at 3200'.

These changes lower the kickout point to below the PC top, therefore proper plugging of the PC can occur at a later date.
