DETAILS OF WORK

*State names listed are self-reported. The top five states by number of workers with any type of part-time job indicate muddling jobs. Percentages are based on the total population of all other persons in proposed work.

It is intended to re-work this well in the following manner:

- A. If tubing can be pulled:
 - 1. Pull tubing, mud up and clean out to 5750'.
 - 2. Run 4 1/2" long string & cement.
 - 3. Perforate and fracture, clean out and run tubing.
- B. If tubing cannot be pulled:
 - 1. Run free point and cut tubing 50' - 100' below 7" casing shoe.
 - 2. Set 7" retainer at approximately 5100' & squeeze open hole.
 - 3. Set whipstock & drill to 5750'. Run 4 1/2" casing and cement.
 - 4. Complete as above.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geologist at Mines before operations may be commenced.
