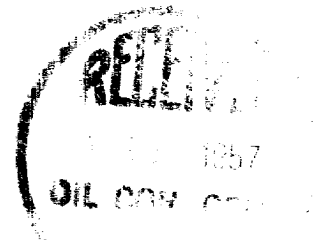
Gentlemen:

On July 30 another dead weight pressure was taken on your well No. 5 Nordhaus, located in the SW¹ sec. 12, T. 31 N., R. 9 W., N. M. P. M., on above referenced lease. Four pressures have now been taken during a period of five or six weeks, they are as follows: 763 psi, 819 psi, 851 psi and 898 psi. These pressures indicate that gas is being thiefed by some zone or formation other than the zone from which the gas is coming.

You are requested to show cause why you should not be required to complete the well in a manner satisfactory to this office and to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission or to plug and abandon the well.
