Gentlemen:

We have your letter of November 15th regarding a well drilled by Compass Exploration Company, and advising that it would be necessary for us to file a Form C-110 on this well.

Compass Exploration Company drilled the Humble North Kirtland Well No. 1-13 under a Farm Out Agreement with Humble with Humble retaining an override but no working interest. Since Humble was the operator of the North Kirtland Unit we were required by the USGS to file the Lessee's Monthly Report of Operations. The well is now shut in, so we have done nothing toward taking over physical operation of the lease, although it is possible we may do so in the future. A C-110 was filed by Compass on May 10, 1962 and we do not believe we should file another one unless it is finally determined that we are to actually operate this well.

If, with the above explanation, you still require a C-110 to be filed, please advise.
