DETAILS OF WORK

(State nature of and expected results of operations; show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casing; indicate measuring points, and all other important proposed work)

Loaded hole with oil. Installed DOPE. Pulled tubing and packer. Set bridge plug on wireline. Ran tubing and packer. Set packer at 6540'. Hipped up wire. Tested bridge plug to 3000 psi, O.K. Perforated selectively 6575-6603' with 12 shots. Stub tested. Recovered 10 BO, 207 BW in 7 days. 4-15-64, acidized perforations with 5000 gallons. After flow back of load, well flowed 20 BW per hour with no show of oil. CI 46,000 ppm. Shut well in 4-16-64. Killed well, removed tree, hipped up BHT 4-30-64. Set cement retainer at 6550', and tested to 2100 psi, O.K. Squeezed perforations 6575-6603' with 150 sx. cement. Ran tubing and set packer at 6495'. Perforated 6523-6530 with 8 shots. Swabbed. Well flowed 12 barrels oil, 47 barrels water in 2 hours, 5-2-64. Produced 120, 120 BW in 11 days. Shut-in well 5-14-64.
