roads and pipelines in the vicinity of the proposed new well.

Water for drilling and completion operations will be obtained  
from the following location: water hole located in the NE/4  
Section 10, T-31-N, R-11-W.

Waste material will be disposed of by burial in the burn pit,  
latrine, or reserve pit as applicable. There will be no camp  
nor air strip associated with drilling this well. Upon  
completion or abandonment of this well, the location will be  
cleaned and leveled and a dry hole marker placed, if applicable.

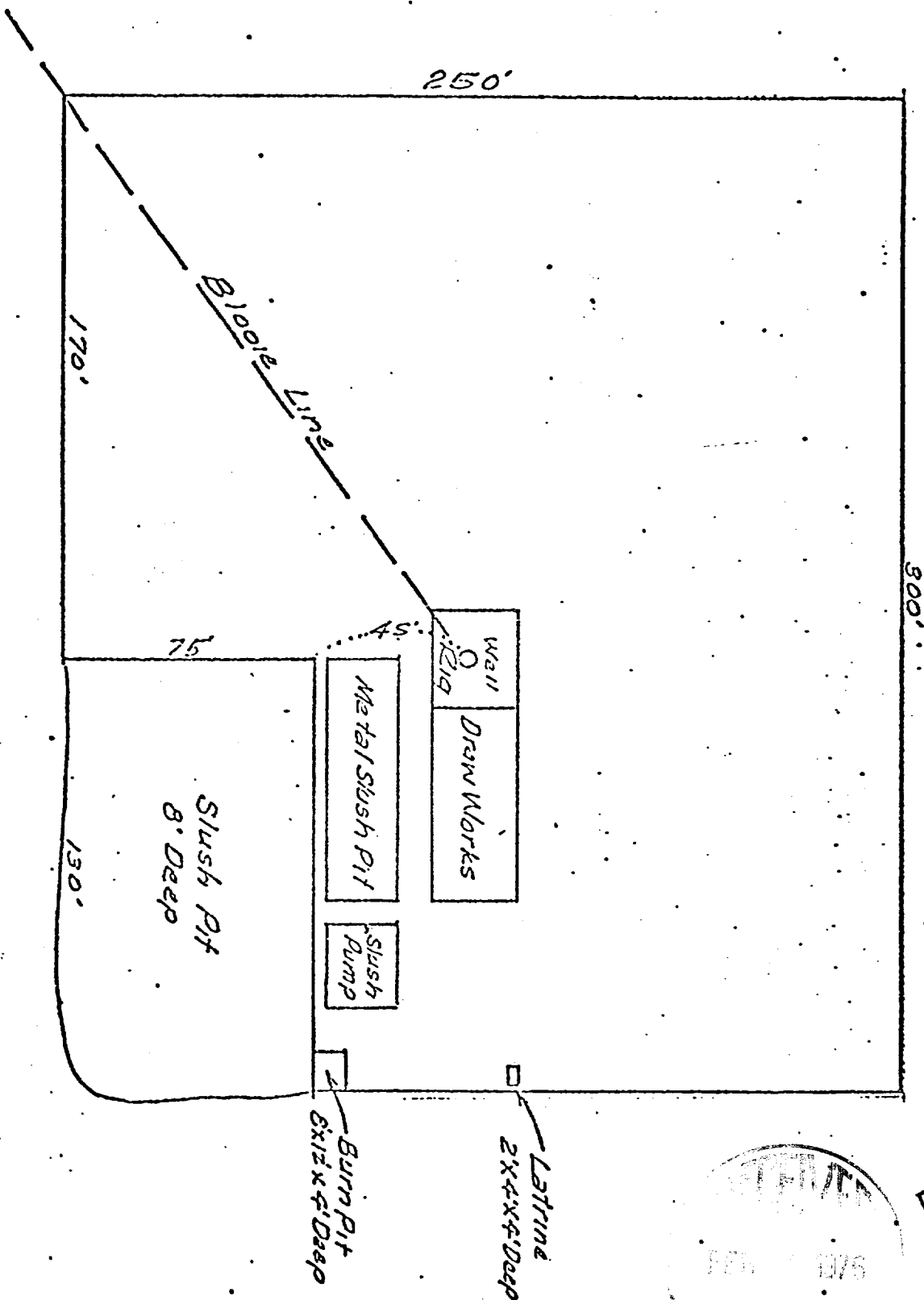
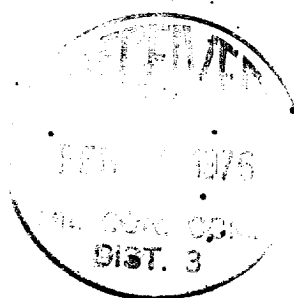

# LOCATION AND EQUIPMENT LAY-OUT Fields Com #12

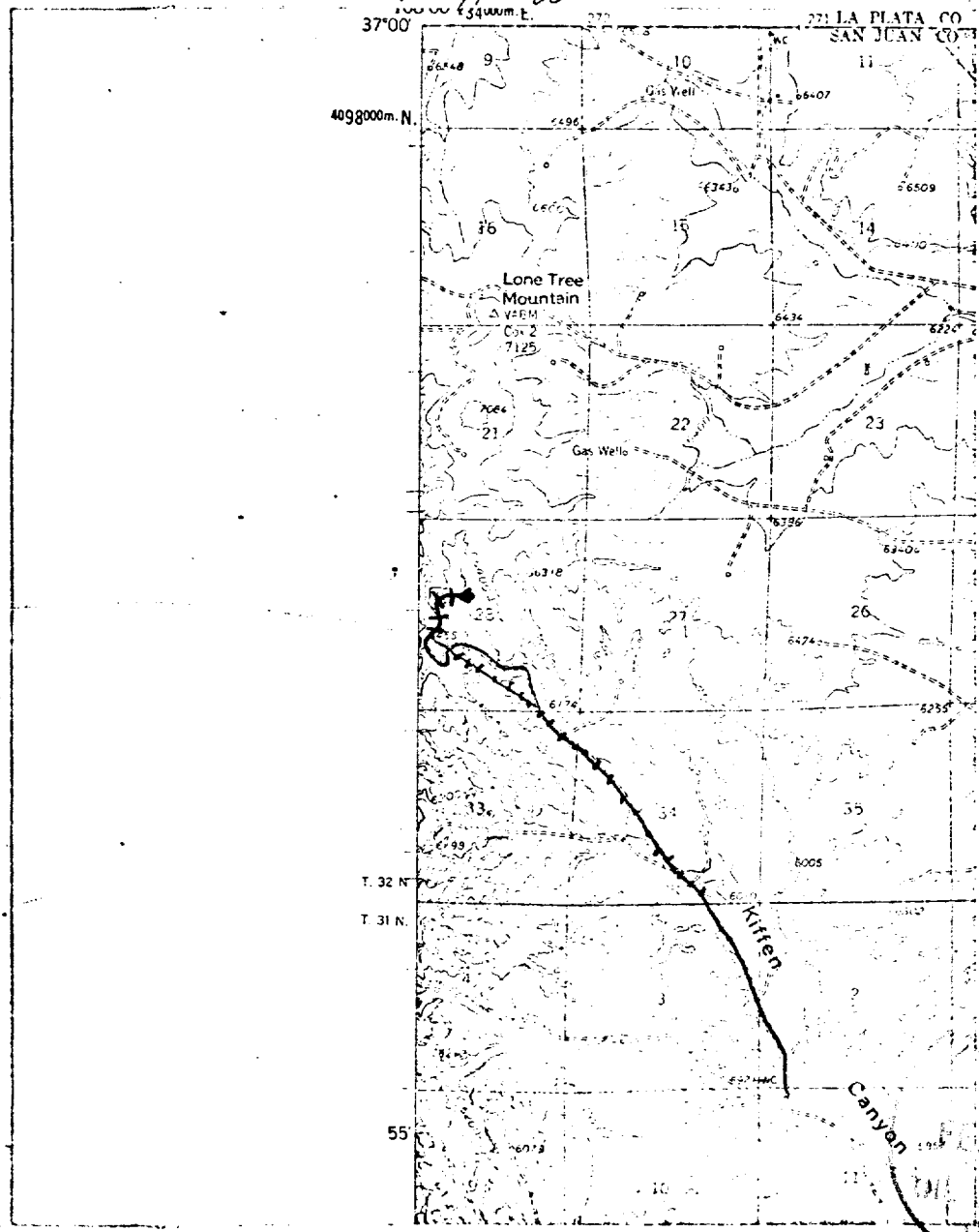
