THE APPLICATION OF EL PASO NATURAL GAS COMPANY FOR A DUAL COMPLETION

ORDER NO. MC-2528

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, El Paso Natural Gas Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division on March 14, 1979, for permission to dually complete its Riddle B Well No. 1A located in Unit I of Section 27, Township 30 North, Range 10 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the Aztec-Pictured Cliffs Pool and from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool.

Now, on this 4th day of April, 1979, the Division Director finds:

- (1) That application has been filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Division's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, El Paso Natural Gas Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Riddle B Well No. 1A located in Unit I of Section 27, Township 30 North, Range 10 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the Aztec-Pictured Cliffs Pool and from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

 $\underline{PROVIDED\ HOWEVER},$ That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

 $\underline{\text{PROVIDED FURTHER}}, \text{ That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter.}$

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Divison may deem necessary.
