Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your well No. 2 Holder A, SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. 6, T. 30 N.,  
R. 12 W., San Juan County, New Mexico, lease Santa Fe 077482. We are  
in receipt of your request to temporarily abandon this well.

Please submit a completion report within 15 days from the date of this  
letter. The report should indicate all perforations and treatments  
performed as well as the results of your testing any zones. Upon review  
of the completion report, if it shows all perforations are below the  
bridge plug at 4650', approval of your request to temporarily abandon  
will be in order.

Any temporary abandonment approved will be for a period of one year and  
you will be required at the end of that time to show cause why the well  
should not be permanently plugged and abandoned. Authority for these  
actions is contained in 30 CFR 221 parts .34 Well Abandonment and .59  
Log and History of Well.

This action is subject to administrative appeal pursuant to 30 CFR 290.
