13. Describe Proposed or Completed Operations

It is intended to pull the Mesaverde and Dakota tubing strings out of this well. Deepen and core the well through the 5 1/2" liner to a new depth of 8270' in the Dakota. The formation will be tested openhole. If sufficient production is seen, a 3 1/2" liner will be run and cemented in place. The Dakota will be perforated and fracture stimulated. The well will then be returned to a dual Mesaverde/Dakota.
