

THE APPLICATION OF MESA PETROLEUM CORP.
FOR A DUAL COMPLETION.

ORDER NO. MC-2984

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A Mesa Petroleum Corp. made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division on January 11, 1982, for permission to dually complete its Bruington Well No. 15E located in Unit F of Section 15, Township 30 North, Range 11 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the Mesaverde Formation and the Basin-Dakota Pool.

Now, on this 4th day of February, 1982, the Division Director finds:

- (1) That application has been filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Division's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified;
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule;
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights; and
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Mesa Petroleum Corp., be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Bruington Well No. 15E located in Unit F of Section 15, Township 30 North, Range 11 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the Mesaverde Formation and the Basin-Dakota Pool through parallel strings of tubing.


PROVIDED HOWEVER, that applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, that applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Division may deem necessary.
