Dear Mr. Ramey:

As operator of the Northeast Blanco Unit, we are requesting administrative approval of a non-standard well location to be completed in the Mesaverde Formation.

We intend to drill the Northeast Blanco Unit Well No. 54A, an infill well, located 1190' F/SL - 2040' F/EL, D-33-31N-7W, San Juan County, New Mexico.

This location is on Federal Royalty, and under the surface control of the United States Bureau of Land Management, who has witnessed this proposed well site. It is located on a small flat mesa with steep cliffs to the South and East down to the Navajo Lake, and without unnecessary expense is the most logical well site agreeable to all parties.

All offset acreage is within the bounds of the Northeast Blanco Unit and will not present a drainage problem to any other operator.
