Williams proposes to set a Waukesha GL 7042 compressor on the well pad for the Rosa #88 to enhance production. This installation will be for a 60-90 day period until Williams can obtain the necessary permits to construct a permanent compressor site to be located just to the west of the existing Rosa #88 well pad. As of July 15, 1997, the survey for the site was initiated and archaeology would commence therewith. Per phone conversation with Mr. Don Ellsworth of the BLM, Farmington office, Mr. Ellsworth gave verbal approval to set the temporary compressor on the Rosa #88 wellpad with certain stipulations to follow for the permanent site.
