Gentlemen:

An inspection on November 17, 1987, by Barbara an Ende of my staff showed that the following minor gravity problems listed below existed on your No. 3E Maddox WN Federal well located 1190' FSL and 1190' FEL, sec. 24, T. 30 N., R. 13 W., N.M.P.M., lease No. NM-0546.

1. The portions of the well pad not currently used for production must be seeded with BLM Seed Mix No. 2 between July 1 and September 15, 1988.

This requirement is a written order of the authorized officer and failure to comply with a written order within the time frame specified will be subject to an assessment pursuant to 43 CFR 3163.1(a) for the uncorrected violation.

Corrective action is to be completed by September 15, 1988. Failure to comply with the above prescribed work may result in assessments under 43 CFR 3162.1(a) and civil penalties under 43 CFR 3163.2.

Section 109(d)(1) of the Federal Oil and Gas Royalty Management Act of 1982, as implemented by the applicable provisions of the operating regulations at Title 43 CFR 3163.4-1(b)(6)(i), provides that any person who "knowingly or willfully" prepares, maintains, or submits false, inaccurate, or misleading reports, affidavits, records, data, or other written information required by this part shall be liable for a civil penalty of up to \$25,000 per violation for each day such violation continues, not to exceed a maximum of 20 days.

Under provisions of 43 CFR 3165.3, you may request an administrative review of the order(s) described above. Such request, including all supporting documents, must be filed in writing within 20 business days of receipt of this notice and must be filed with the State Director, Bureau of Land Management, P.O. Box 1449, Santa Fe, NM 87504-1449. Such request shall not result in a suspension of the order(s) unless the reviewing official so determines. Procedures governing appeals from instructions, decisions, or orders are contained in 43 CFR 3165.4.
