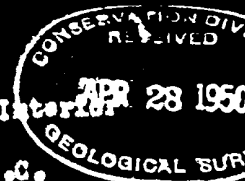

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Secretary of the Interior under the act approved February 25, 1920, 41 Stat. 437, 30 U.S.C. secs. 181 et seq., as amended by the act of August 8, 1946, 60 Stat. 950, and delegated to the Director of the Geological Survey, pursuant to Departmental Order No. 2365 of October 8, 1947, 43 C.F.R. sec. 4.618, 12 F.R. 6784, I do hereby:

- A. Approve the attached communitization agreement covering the S $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. 21, T. 30 N., R. 9 W., E.M.P.M., San Juan County, New Mexico, in the Blanco gas field as to dry gas and/or condensate produced therefrom from formations down to and including the Mesaverde formation.
- B. Determine that the portions of the Federal leaseholds committed to the attached agreement cannot be independently developed and operated in conformity with the accepted well-spacing pattern for the Blanco gas field and that consummation of the agreement will be in the public interest.
- C. Certify and determine that the drilling, producing, rental, minimum royalty, and royalty requirements of the Federal leases committed to said agreement are hereby established, altered, changed, or revoked to conform with the terms and conditions of the agreement.
