IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:


(1) Decretory Paragraph No. (1) on page 4 of Division Order No. R-9813, dated December 28, 1992, be and the same is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

"(1) The applicant, Meridian Oil, Inc., is hereby authorized to drill its Johnston Federal Well No. 270 at an unorthodox coal gas well location 790 feet from the North and West lines (Unit D) of Section 12, Township 30 North, Range 9 West, NMPM, Basin-Fruitland Coal Gas Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico."

(2) The corrections set forth in this order be entered nunc pro tunc as of December 28, 1992.
