O7/11/02 Current Operations: Prepared to frac. Set frac tanks. Set 5000# frac valve on casing. Pressure test casing to 3800#. RU wireline. Run GR/CCL from 1676' to 1150'. Perforate 1535'-1546' 3 SPF 120 degree phasing. Shut in frac valve.
