The Commission has received a report from the State Engineer that the oil reserves in the State of New Mexico are being depleted at a rapid rate. It is recommended that the Commission take immediate action to conserve the oil resources of the State. The Commission should consider the following measures:

1. Establish a system of oil conservation.

3. Investigate the possibility of developing new oil reserves.
