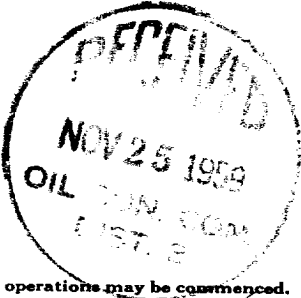

DETAILS OF WORK

Spudded well at midnight - November 22, 1959, and drilled to 168 feet.
Set five joints - 10-3/4" 32# J-55 casing (155.55') at 168 feet, using 150 sacks regular cement - 2% calcium chloride. Circulated cement to surface. Plug down at 12:30 p.m. on November 23, 1959.
