DETAILS OF WORK

Well sand fractured on May 1, 1959 as reported on separate sheets.

May 16, 1959. Well cleaned out with swabbing unit to 5,765 feet. Ran 189 joints (5,757') of 2-3/8" J-55 tubing, with 1 four foot perforated nipple. Landed at 5,769 feet. Well shut in at 11:15 p.m. to await initial potential test and pipe line connection.

Correction of previous information. Form 9-128 attached to notice of intention to drill indicated La Plata Gathering System, Inc. as the sole owner of the 320 acres dedicated to the well. We are now informed the acreage is owned by J. Glenn Turner, Frank A. Schultz, William G. Webb and Benson-Montin-Greer Drilling Corporation, but that all of the acreage has been "unitized" under the San Juan 32-5 Unit.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
