DETAILS OF WORK

11/5/60. Set Baker drillable bridge plug at 5590'. Perforated 2 shots/ft. 5591-90'. 5530-45', & 5520-28', 5501-12', 5481-64'. Treated with 35,000 gal. water, 1% cc. and 75 J-2 welling agent/1000 gal. and 35,000# 20/40 sand. Flushed 5,800 gal. water. Inj. 12.7 BHP. Sand 25 and then 30 ball sealers. On 11/11/60 ran gauge ring to 8090' and Baker Model D production packer to 7800'. Ran Dakota tubing: 236 joints + 3 subs 2-1/16" OD H-80 drill tubing (7773') with 23' tail pipe and 3.6' seal unit - landed in packer at 7800'. Ran Mesa Verde tubing: 175 joints (5825') of 1-1/4" BGS J-55 landed at 5934' gxs.

11/14/60. Start well in to await potential test and pipe line connection.
