

SYSTEM, INC. FOR PERMISSION TO EFFECT DUAL COMPLETION OF ITS SAN JUAN 32-5 UNIT WELL NO. 2-25, LOCATED IN THE NW/4 NE/4 OF SECTION 25, TOWNSHIP 32 NORTH, RANGE 6 WEST, NMFM, RIO ARRIBA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO, IN SUCH A MANNER AS TO PERMIT THE PRODUCTION OF GAS FROM THE BLANCO-MESAVERDE POOL AND THE PRODUCTION OF GAS FROM THE BASIN-DAKOTA POOL.

**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION**

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A(c) La Plata Gathering System, Inc. made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on December 12, 1960 for permission to dually complete its San Juan 32-5 Unit Well No. 2-25, located in the NW/4 NE/4 of Section 25, Township 32 North, Range 6 West, NMFM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool and the production of gas from the Basin-Dakota Pool.

NOW, on this 27th day of December, 1960, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Subsection 'c' of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, La Plata Gathering System, Inc., be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its San Juan 32-5 Unit Well No. 2-25, located in the NW/4 NE/4 of Section 25, Township 32 North, Range 6 West, NMFM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool and the production of gas from the Basin-Dakota Pool, through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Section V, Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Deliverability Test Period for the Basin-Dakota Pool.

from the Basin-DeKota Pool.

New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas
from the Blanco-Mesa Verde Pool and the production of gas from the
Basin-DeKota Pool, through parallel strings of tubing.
