ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on September 11, 1962, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Elvis A. Utz, Examiner duly appointed by the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission," in accordance with Rule 1214 of the Commission Rules and Regulations.

NOW, on this 18th day of October, 1962, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the application, the evidence adduced, and the recommendations of the Examiner, Elvis A. Utz, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That the applicant, La Plata Gathering System, Inc., proposes to drill a gas well at an unorthodox location in the Blanco-Mesaverde Gas Pool, 1790 feet from the North line and 790 feet from the West line of section 24, Township 32 North, Range 6 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.
- (3) That the special Rules and Regulations for the Blanco-Mesaverde Gas Pool require wells to be located 990 feet from the outer boundary of either the NE/4 or SW/4 of the section.
- (4) That the applicant has failed to establish that a well drilled in the SW/4 of Section 24 in accordance with the special Rules and Regulations for the Blanco-Mesaverde Gas Pool will not efficiently and economically drain the NW/4 of said Section 24.
- (5) That the drilling of a Blanco-Mesaverde gas well in the NW/4 of Section 24 will leave unrecoverable gas in the SW/4 of said section, thereby causing waste.

(6) That the application should be denied.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(1) That the subject application is hereby denied.

(2) That jurisdiction of this cause is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
