### DETAILS OF WORK

The above well was drilled to a total depth of 11,533'. As a result of failing to find oil or gas in commercial quantities, we propose to plug and abandon the uncased portion of the hole as follows:

1. Spot 100 sacks plug 11,100-11,300 (Mississippian).
2. Spot 30 sacks plug 8,300-8,400 (Pennsylvanian).
3. Spot 30 sacks plug 7,100-7,300 (Triassic-Chinle).
4. Spot 30 sacks plug 6,750-6,850 (Mudra).
5. Spot 75 sacks plug 6,000-6,150 (9-5/8" casing set at 6,092').

Completion attempt will be made in the Dakota Formation.



I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.

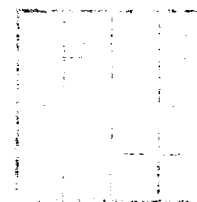
