FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK
(FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

It is proposed to abandon subject well on July 3, 1962, in the following manner:

Spot cement plugs as follows: 25 ex. plugs 1320-1430', 990-1100', and 287-387' and a 10 ex. plug from 0-30' in the 8-5/8" surface casing. A 4" marker pipe will be cemented in top of 8-5/8" surface casing. The pits will be filled and leveled and the location will be cleared and cleaned of all debris.

NOTE: This well is located 10,939.2' S 34° 30' W of Mile Post 193 on Colorado-New Mexico state line.
