
Dear Sir/Madam:

This letter is to advise you that the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division has filed the enclosed application seeking a Show Cause Hearing requiring CMS Oilfield Services, Inc., John Caranta dba Cardel Oil Company and/or Caranta Brothers and United States Fidelity and Guaranty Company to appear and show cause why it/they should not be ordered to plug and abandon the above-referenced well.

This application has been set for hearing before an Examiner of the Oil Conservation Division on March 21, 1996. You are not required to attend this hearing, but as an owner of an interest that may be affected by an order issued in this cause, you may appear and present testimony. Failure to appear at that time and become a party of record will preclude you from challenging the matter at a later date.

Parties appearing in cases have been requested by the Division (Memorandum 20-90--- Enclosed) to file a Prehearing Statement substantially in the form prescribed by the Division. Prehearing statements should be filed by 4:00 o'clock p.m. on the Friday before a scheduled hearing.
