Reference is made to your application of December 15, 1988 for a non-standard coal gas well location for your Carracas Mesa 14 Well No. 1 to be located 1100 feet from the North and West lines (Unit D) of Section 14, Township 32 North, Range 4 West, NMPM, Basin Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. The N/2 of said Section 14 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.
