

Dear Ms. Perrin:

Reference is made to your application of August 8, 1989 for a non-standard coal gas well location for your [REDACTED] located 1850 feet from the North line and 790 feet from the West line ([REDACTED] North Range [REDACTED], NMPM, Basin Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. The W/2 of said Section 28 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.
