Dear Ms. Perrin:

Reference is made to your application of February 13, 1989 to amend Division Administrative Order NSL-2588 to include the Basin-Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool. Said NSL-2588, dated October 4, 1988, authorized a non-standard gas well location for the Carracas Unit 36-A Well No. 1 to be drilled 430 feet from the North line and 800 feet from the East line (Unit A) of Section 36, Township 32 North, Range 5 West, NMPM, to test the Undesignated Cottonwood-Fruitland Pool, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, the NE/4 of said Section 15 to be dedicated to said well forming a standard 160-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 8 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8768, the above-described well is hereby approved as an unorthodox coal gas well location. The E/2 of said Section 36 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool. Furthermore, other provisions of the original order shall remain in full force and effect until further notice.


