DETAILS OF WORK

Permission was granted to temporarily abandon this well in February, 1959. Since that time preliminary studies have shown this field to be an excellent waterflood prospect. We propose to continue carrying this well as temporarily abandoned until such time as it may be needed for a water source well from greater depths. We normally do not desire to carry a well in the TA status for an extended period. In this case, however, our proposed action seems warranted since waterflooding in the future seems to be a certainty. As stated previously, the 8-5/8" O.D. surface casing was left full of 9.0# mud, and an 8-5/8"x2" swadge and a 2" plug valve are installed on top of the surface casing.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.

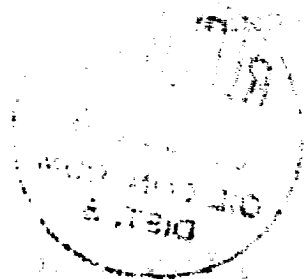
