1/9/97 A-Plus Well Service mixed and pumped 41 sacks Class B cement, plug from 1425' to 894' to cover Gallup top and perforations. Tag cement top at 1078'. Perforated squeeze holes at 210'. Mixed and pumped 90 sacks Class B neat cement. Circulated cement from annulus and left casing full. Cut off wellhead and installed regulation dry hole marker with 20 sacks of cement.

Casing remaining in hole:

Surface casing: 8-5/8", 24#, J-55 casing to 95'

Production casing: 4-1/2", 9.5#, J-55 to 1499'
