DETAILS OF WORK

Total depth 892'. Plugged and abandoned.

This well was drilled to a total depth of 892' and after testing and plugging back to a depth of 750' without encountering any commercial production, well was plugged and abandoned as follows:

Pumped 100 sacks of cement down 7" casing with fill-up from 750' to 479'. Spotted 4' cement plug in top of 7" casing. Cut off well head and cemented 4" pipe marker in top of hole with 4' extending above ground level.

Verbal approval to plug this well received from Mr. Jerry Long, Supervisor, Jan. 1960.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
