This well will be dually completed in the Pictured Cliffs-Mesa Verde as a gas-gas dual. A packer will be installed on the 2 3/8" tubing between the zones with a sidedoor choke installed in the 2 3/8" tubing above the production packer. Upon final successful completion, a formal application for administrative approval will be made to the Oil Conservation Commission in Santa Fe.
