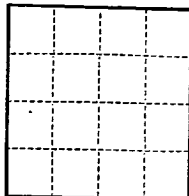

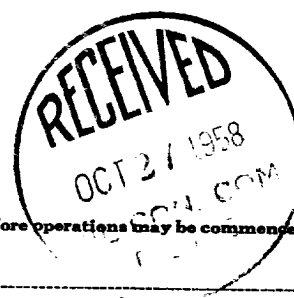

Ran Gamma Ray Log 950-1355'. Perforated 1327-1349' Schlumberger and Gamma Ray with 88 15/32" bullets. Treated perforations with 10,000 gallons lease crude containing 10,000# 10/20 sand. Formation broke down 2,000-1000#. Initial treating pressure 1000#, final treating pressure 1200#. Average injection rate 36 BPM. Job complete 10:30 A.M., 10-17-58.
