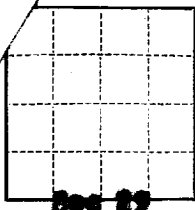

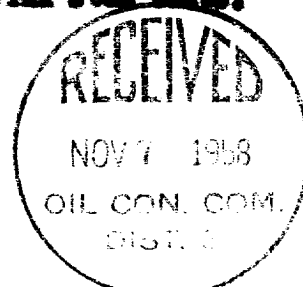

DETAILS OF WORK

A 12 1/2" hole was drilled to 118' and 8-5/8" surface pipe was set at 113' with 100 sx neat cement. Cement was circulated to surface. The pipe was tested with 1000 psi water pressure. Presently the well is being drilled with a 7-7/8" bit at 36400. There have been no cures or drill stem tests.
