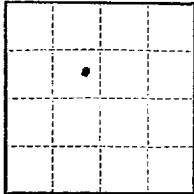

DETAILS OF WORK

(State names of and expected depths to objective sands; show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudding jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work)

A 7-7/8" hole was drilled to 3945' and 5 1/2" casing was set at that point. The pipe was cemented in two stages with the stage tool set at 2837'. The first stage consisted of 100 sx of neat cement and the second stage consisted of 175 sx neat cement. There was an eight hour waiting period between stages. A 4-3/4" hole was then drilled to 4100' with cable tools. While attempting to frac the open hole, the well sandied up. While cleaning out the frac sand, the tools became stuck in the hole, and it has not been possible to remove them. A whipstock will therefore be set above the fish, a window will be cut in the casing, and a new hole will be drilled to TD.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
