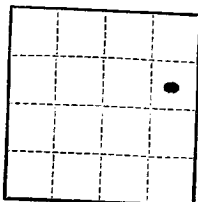

The open hole interval 3855'-4024' was fraced with 15,500 gallons crude and 7750 pounds of sand at 1275 psi and 53 barrel per minute. The hole was cleaned out from 3755' to 4024' and the well was placed on production.
