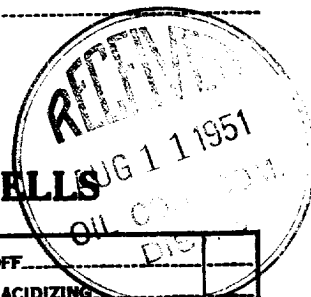

We propose to drill with rotary tools to the Cliffhouse sand and set 7" casing, rotary tools will then be employed using gas to drill thru the Cliffhouse, Manafee, and Painthook for Mesa Verde completion. Well will then be shot with 3HO in the Mesa Verde Section.

Casing Program:

250' of 10-3/4" Surface Casing - Circulate cement to surface
4300' of 7" 20" Casing - 200 sacks of regular cement
4500' of 2" or 1.9" OD J-55 tubing - Production string.

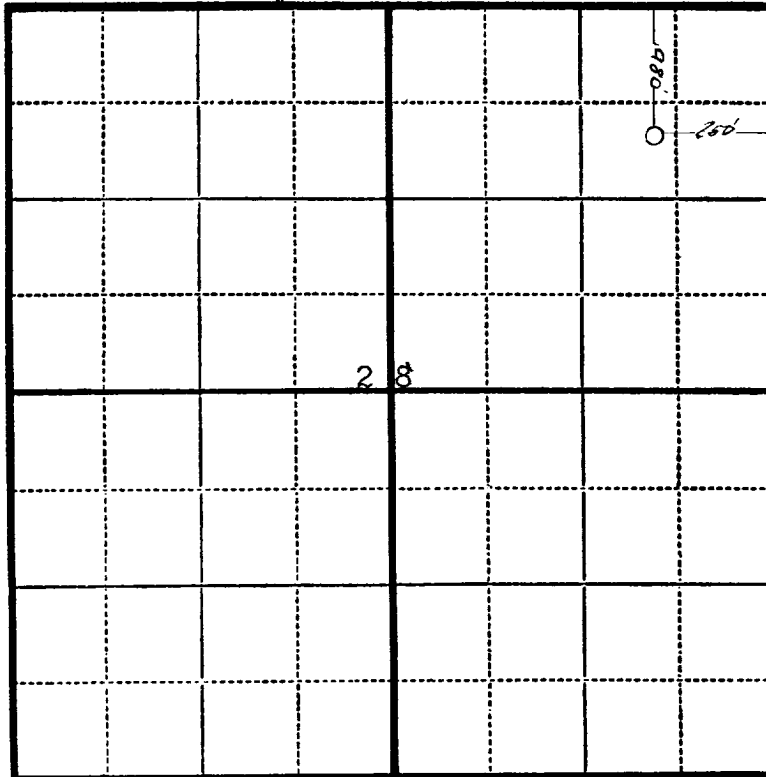
