It is understood that this unit is to be dedicated to your Templeton Well No. 1-27, located 1760 feet from the West line and 1810 feet from the North line of said Section 27.

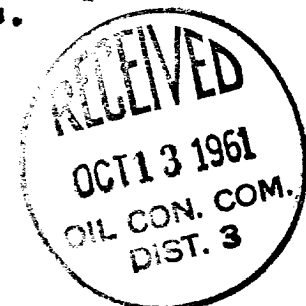

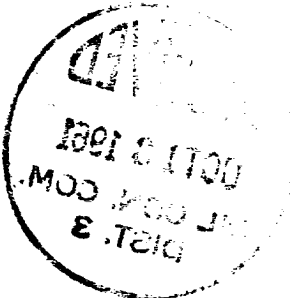
