

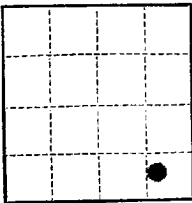

TD 3854. Ran B J Service logs. Set 4 1/8" casing at 3854' with 90 sacks cement. Cemented B V Tool at 2515' with 90 sacks cement. Ran Temperature Survey - top cement 2790'. Cemented 2nd stage with 90 sacks, top cement 2090'. Tested for 2 hours with 900# pressure, pipe O.K.
