DETAILS OF WORK

It is intended to drill a well with rotary tools thru the Mesa Verde formation. Mud circulation will be used thru the Pictured Cliffs and set intermediate casing. Gas circulation will be used thru the Mesa Verde and production liner will be set. Possible productive intervals will be perforated and fractured. Estimated total depth 4000'.

Casing Program:

- 10 3/4" at 100' with 120 sacks cement circulated to the surface.
- 7 7/8" at 2500' with 250 sacks cement.
- 5 1/2" at 4000' with 300 sacks cement.

The 1/2 of Section 22 is dedicated to this well.
